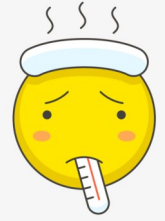
Kia Ora

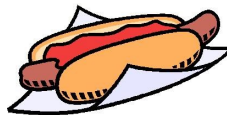
PTA News
